Once documents are submitted, applicants will be interviewed by Student Development, and will prepare an essay on campus about a topic randomly selected. Applicants are evaluated based on overall profile. Decision is announced via email approximately two to four weeks after interview.

By signing this application, applicants agree to the following terms:

- Applicants must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the corresponding academic year, found at <http://fafsa.ed.gov>. JMVU's school code is 041620.
- Applicants are responsible for maintaining a minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Applicants are responsible for 20 volunteer hours per semester for the partial scholarship and 40 hours per semester for the full scholarship at JMVU, in the case the university may request it.
- Once awarded, students must always represent the university in a positive manner.
- Failure to follow these expectations can and will lead to the revocation of academic scholarships.
- If the student drops or fails courses, the student will lose the scholarship.
- In case of withdrawal, students will be financially liable for full tuition of the classes enrolled at JMVU for the semester in course.
