

Dear Student,

If you have been awarded student loans, then you must complete two important requirements before your award may be disbursed to you:

1. Entrance Counseling
2. Master Promissory Note

Step 1: Go to <http://studentloans.gov>

You may change the language of the page in the top right corner (see **red arrow**).

Step 2: Sign in using your federal pin (the same you used for filling out the FAFSA)

Step 3: Complete Entrance Counseling / (en español, *Asesoramiento de Entrada*)

Step 4: Sign Master Promissory Note / (en español, *Pagaré Maestro o MPN*)

Step 5: Turn in proof of completion to Financial Aid Office at JMVU.
